RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COACHELLA VALLEY DESERT CAMERA CLUB, INC.

The undersigned certify that:

- 1. They are the president and the secretary, respectively, of Coachella Valley Desert Camera Club, Inc., a California Corporation.
- 2. The Articles of Incorporation of this corporation are amended and restated to read as follows:

The name of the corporation is Coachella Valley Desert Camera Club, Inc.

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to provide for the enjoyment, mastery, and furtherance of photography through cooperation, effort, and fellowship among persons interested in the photographic arts.

- A. The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes

and which has established its tax exempt status under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).

- The foregoing amendment and restatement of Articles of Incorporation have been duly approved by the Board of Directors.
- 4. The foregoing amendment and restatement of Articles of Incorporation have been duly approved by a unanimous vote of the members.
